# Lulling you to sleep... with ICD-10 sleep codes

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As we continue our adventure into ICD-10 with the sleep codes, one will notice a couple of new instructions, “code first” and “code with.” The “code first” direction will be found with codes where the diagnosis is a manifestation of another disease. For example, with *G47.42 Narcolepsy in conditions classified elsewhere*, one sees the “code first” direction. If the narcolepsy was a result of an intracranial injury, then the correct coding sequence would be a code from the S06 family (eg, *S06.0X1 Concussion with loss of consciousness of 30 minutes or less*) followed by either *G47.421* or

*G47.472*, dependent upon the presence or absence of cataplexy.

According to the **ICD-10-CM Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting** available at [www.cms.gov/Medicare/Coding/ICD10/2015-ICD-10-CM-and-GEMs.html](http://www.cms.gov/Medicare/Coding/ICD10/2015-ICD-10-CM-and-GEMs.html), the “code also” note instructs that two codes may be required to fully describe a condition, but this note does not provide sequencing direction. The ICD-10 CM codes for common sleep diagnoses are listed below. Please note that the *G25.81 restless legs syndrome* diagnosis is not found in “Sleep disorders” code set but rather in the G25 “Other extrapyramidal and movement disorders” set. Sweet dreams!
