OBJECTIVES

The Industry Advisory Council will:

- Serve as a forum for the corporate community and CHEST to discuss key issues and their implications.
- Provide a setting for discussions on technical and business trends that may influence CHEST and corporate strategic planning decisions.
- Provide feedback to CHEST for corporate development and funding opportunities.

GOVERNANCE

- The IAC is an ad hoc committee that serves at the pleasure of the CHEST Board of Regents.
- The IAC is an advisory group that provides information and recommendations to CHEST and its Board of Regents. It does not take action on behalf of, or speak for, CHEST.
- The IAC may make recommendations to the CHEST Board of Regents and CHEST Philanthropy Board of Advisors, as applicable, which will review and act upon such recommendations as each board deems prudent.
- Membership acceptance on the IAC does not imply endorsement of any products or services by CHEST.
- The IAC will have a Chair and Vice-Chair elected for a two-year term by its members. The Vice-Chair will serve in the absence of the Chair and, at the discretion of the IAC, will be eligible to serve as Chair upon completion of the two-year term. If the Vice-Chair chooses not to serve as Chair, a new Chair and Vice-Chair will be elected.
- If both the Chair and Vice-Chair positions are vacated prior to a meeting of the IAC, a new Chair will be selected via email election prior to the meeting, who will serve the remainder of the then-current term. A Vice-Chair will be elected at the next regular meeting of the IAC to serve the remainder of the then-current term.
- The IAC will meet twice per year at the time and place designed by CHEST. One of those meetings will be held during the CHEST Annual Meeting.
- CHEST reserves the right to enact additional rules or requirements as it deems necessary.

Clinical Trial Postings

- IAC members can post up to three different clinical trials, for a 90-day period each, on the CHEST Clinical Trials webpage: chestnet.org/membership-and-community/membership/clinical-trials-registry
- To post a current trial, please email the following to Rachel Cahill:
 - 75-character headline (including spaces)
 - 700-character blurb (including spaces)
 - A URL can also be provided to link out to more information
- Trials will be posted in a timely manner upon receipt
- Each posts will remain on the page for 90 days, unless asked to be taken down sooner

One Five-Question Pulse Survey
